Comparable vs. Non-Comparable Hospitals

Table A-1: Non-Comparable Hospitals in the State of California, by Category A-2

“Comparable” is the default selection for the OSHPD data and includes all hospitals that submitted a full annual financial disclosure report (i.e., without any reporting modifications). However, some hospitals, designated as “non-comparable,” have unique characteristics, and have been granted modifications to the annual reporting requirements. In order to avoid inaccurate or misleading information, data for “non-comparable” hospitals were excluded from both the OSHPD default analysis, as well as the AHIP analysis, but have been included here for reference.¹

KAISER: *By law, Kaiser Foundation Hospitals are allowed to submit consolidated financial statements for its Northern and Southern Regions and limited financial and payroll data for the individual hospitals located in those regions. Kaiser does not report gross revenue (charges) for services provided because they serve primarily health plan members. These include:*
